




Texas Risk Assessment for Type 2 Diabetes in Children (TRAT2DC)

- **The online certification is not a timed training**
- **Certification training time ranges between 1 to 2 hours – Note: User must be prepared to devote time necessary as system will not save progress!**

- **The training will consist of 5 modules: which includes:**
 - **Introduction**
 - **Assessing for Acanthosis Nigricans**
 - **Conducting Heights and Weights**
 - **Blood Pressure Measures in Children**
 - **Reporting and Referral Process**

- **At the beginning of each module, will be given the module objectives**
- **At the end of each module, requires to answer a few questions before moving on to the next module**
- **If the response is incorrect, it will be given a quick review and will have an opportunity to answer the question correctly**

- **Upon completion of the training, participant will be required to complete the certification form:**
 - **First, Last name**
 - **ISD and Campus**
 - **City, State, Zip Code**
 - **E-mail/Phone Number**
- **At the end of the training, a certificate is available to print/view. Certification is granted for 5 years, beginning on the day of the training.**
